Re: Sportsmanship Banner Attachment Program

A year ago, each member school received a CHSAA banner that (1) Provided recognition as member school, and (2) Reference the sportsmanship of “We Cheer For Our Team.”

As you can see, an attachment to the bottom of that banner has been created to include four stars over the next four years: 10-11, 11-12, 12-13, 13-14. Each star represents the fact that your school has signed a contract to (1) meet with your student body and fans three times at the beginning of each sports season to stress that when cheering, your school Cheers For Your Team and not against your opponent, (2) participate in CHSAA’s Random Acts of Sportsmanship Initiative to reward, through the simple acknowledgement of a certificate, those student-athletes and education-coaches who are role models of random acts of positive sporting behavior in your school, and (3) send in Game Management Preseason Planning Form . Information on all three of these items can be found in your sportsmanship packet included with your school box.
