- Duals.....\$36.00
  - Sub-Varsity.....\$27.50
- Triangular or larger meet /per session...\$41.00
  - Sub Varsity.....\$31.00

Note: 4 certified officials should be used in meets with 6 or more teams.

Pre-Qualifying Meets

- One session meet (less than 5 or 6 teams).....\$55.00
- Extended Meet (2 session or more than 6 teams)...\$109.00
- Multiple day Meet.....\$136.00

Cross Country Meet.....\$36.00

**RefPay**

RefPay is a new system where schools, conferences and officials associations transfer funds electronically. The most common use will be for schools and associations to pay officials' game fees. CHSAA will use this method of payment for all state tournament and events to pay their officials.

To create a RefPay account go to [www.rerpay.com](http://www.rerpay.com) and click Sign-up/Register and start the six step registration process.

Officials signed up with Arbiter may then click on the RefPay link attached to Arbiter and follow the step to inter proper info. This is how you will be able to follow being paid and getting paid for events.
