

STATE OFFICIALS CRITERIA

VOLLEYBALL

DEADLINE: October 9, 2009

If you wish to be considered as an official for the state tournament, please read the criteria and then using the CHSAA Arbiter site check that you have read and met the criteria for selection to the state tournament, **no later than October 9, 2009.**

Only certified, patched officials are eligible to officiate for the state tournament. The CHSAA will select the officials and assign them to work the state volleyball tournament from the list of applicants provided by the CHSAA Arbiter site.

To be considered as a State Tournament official, you MUST have:

1. Scored 90% or higher on the open book test (to be submitted by your Area Director)
2. Officiated a minimum of eight (8) varsity matches during the fall season.
3. Paid your CVOA membership dues and be a member of CVOA in good standing as of October 9, 2009
4. Turned in your area availability by the deadline in your area and be in compliance with your area requirements.
5. Meet the October 9, 2009 deadline to apply for the post season.
6. Attended required meetings, clinics, and other CHSAA/CVOA requirements by October 9, 2009.
7. Consistently apply and implement NF and CHSAA rule modifications of the game, including official's uniform code
8. Have been a CVOA certified patched official for a minimum of three (3) years

On the CHSAA Arbiter site you will be able to indicate your desire to work the state tournament and supply the following information:

Conflict of interest:

At the site name any high school where you may have a conflict of interest or any high school which you would prefer to avoid. Example: A high school where you have taught, attended school, a relative teaches, a friend coaches, relatives live in the community, etc.

Dates of State Volleyball:

November 12 (officials clinic and CVOA banquet), 13, & 14
